## GDPR PRIVACY STATEMENT

To enable us to validate and maintain membership and determine membership an amount of personal data will be processed. This data will be processed using both consent and contractual obligation as the legal basis for processing under the General Data Protection Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (**GDPR**), Article 6. Lindum Sports Association (**LSA**) will treat that personal data fairly, responsibly and in a transparent manner.

Lindum Sports Association will process your personal data in a manner that is legal, effective and efficient. We will apply ethical best practice at the root of decision making, while protecting your privacy and confidentiality, as described in our Data Protection Policy and Procedures. The General Data Protection Regulation gives you the following rights regarding the processing of your personal data:

**Right to be informed** about how your data is processed and why in a concise, transparent, intelligible and easily accessible way.

**Right to access your personal data** and verify the lawfulness of the processing.

**Right to rectification** if the personal data we hold about you is inaccurate or incomplete.

**Right to erasure** or removal of your personal data where there is no compelling / legal / financial reason for its continued processing.

**Right to restrict processing**, to 'block' or suppress processing of your personal data.

**Right to data portability** allows you to receive your personal data we hold in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format, and to transmit those data to another data controller.

**Right to object** to processing your data based on legitimate interests or the performance of a task in the public interest/exercise of official authority (including profiling), direct marketing or processing for purposes of scientific/historical research and statistics.

**Rights related to automated decision making.** Lindum Sports Association does not employ automated decision-making processes.

The Lindum Sports Association Board is responsible for protecting the personal data held by the Lindum Sports Association by ensuring the company has a suitably robust information governance function, supported by appropriate policies and processes.
