

THE LINDUM SPORTS ASSOCIATION.

SAFEGUARDING AND PROTECTING YOUNG PEOPLE IN SPORT.

The LINDUM SPORTS ASSOCIATION (L S A) adopts the Safeguarding and Protecting Young People Policies of the Constituent Clubs in the Association, and works in accordance with the following statement. (The L S A is defined below).

Introduction

The Lindum Sports Association is committed to creating and maintaining a safe and positive environment for all young people involved in sport. It accepts its responsibility to help safeguard the welfare of all young people.

Every individual and organisation within the Lindum Sports Association has a role and responsibility to help ensure the safety and welfare of young people

Every group of young persons coming to these premises must be accompanied by at least one responsible adult, whether a parent, school teacher or supervisor, sports coach or supervisor, and will be subject to the requirements of the Safeguarding and Protection Policy of the organisation to which the supervisor and/or young person belongs.

Definitions:

The Lindum Sports Association ; - all individuals, clubs, associations, and other organisations involved in any capacity in any sport attending or visiting or making use of the facilities of the Lindum Ground or Clubhouse. For the avoidance of doubt, this includes all players and anyone working within the Lindum Ground (in a paid or voluntary capacity, and whether as an employee or on a self-employed or other work basis) including all coaches, umpires, referees and other officials.

The Lindum Sports Association requires all Clubs and Organisations using the premises to display the details of their Safeguarding and Protection Policy together with the persons to be contacted in the case of any incident requiring their attention.

The details of contact also to be provided to the Clubhouse manager for the attention of the Clubhouse staff.
